Footnotes

MISS GRIMSBY bobbled at the start but sped between rivals to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail and proved best under urging. PENINSULA GIRL, came a bit off the rail chasing the winner leaving the first turn, inched forward leaving the second turn, found the fence for the stretch but could make no late impact while saving the place. DRAWING A BLANK, between rivals much of the way to the second turn, continued outside PENINSULA GIRL on that bend and into the stretch and was edged for second. ST. EULALIA, saved ground outrun early, came out into the stretch and improved position. AFFIRMED MISS, chased the winner four wide, dropped back and angled in some leaving the second turn and weakened. SUNLEY SEEKER (GB) three deep early, went up three deep between foes on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and also weakened. STYLISH TALENT, angled in and saved ground close up early, remained inside, dropped back and gave way.
