ALL THE GEARS chased outside a rival, moved up outside leaving the second turn, bid four wide into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and won clear under left handed urging. CAVEOLIN stalked the leaders outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses through much of the drive, could not match the winner but gained the place. SPYCAT saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn, was stuck behind rivals into the stretch, continued blocked in midstretch, steadied, then split foes and picked up the show. HOOK CALL (BRZ) angled in and set a pressured pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn, fought back in midstretch, came a bit off the rail in deep stretch and weakened between foes late. TOP HONOURS saved ground stalking the pace, waited a bit leaving the second turn, lacked room inside in the stretch, then got through late. COME BACK RONNIE pulled a bit early, saved ground chasing the leaders, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GOOD COP BAD COP angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival, dropped back a bit leaving the second turn, was in tight between foes in midstretch and weakened. EDITOR IN CHIEF off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace and was outrun. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled no runners could be blamed for the trouble.
