QUICK COVER angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, stalked that one midway on the turn, re-bid leaving the bend, took a short lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some late urging. MY TINA came out at the start, sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, inched away briefly midway on the turn, fought back into the stretch but could not match the winner late. APOLLO WON off a bit slowly, went up inside to chase the leaders, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. SUSPICIOUS TOWN saved ground off the pace, moved up some leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and edged a rival late for fourth. MUCH chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, continued along the rail in the stretch and lacked a response. FUZZY CHAI also chased a bit off the rail then went between foes on the turn and did not rally. THE IT GIRL between foes early, settled

just off the inside, angled in on the turn, came out a bit in the stretch and was not a threat. HOLY REQUEST bumped after the start, chased between horses then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. JADELICIOUS bumped at the start and a bit slow into stride, moved up outside to chase the leaders, went four wide into the turn and three deep on the bend and weakened in the lane. BELLARAMA close up stalking the pace off the rail, dropped back between foes on the turn and gave way. ADANCINGSCORE wide and unhurried early, angled in some on the turn and was outrun. STRIKING JAKLIN forced out and bumped at the start, settled between foes, dropped back leaving the backstretch and gave way.
