JAKE SKATE was sent along outside to gain the early lead, angled in on the first turn, dueled between foes leaving that bend then outside a rival, regained the advantage into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and won clear under urging. HOTEL HALL (IRE) moved up four wide with a bid leaving the first turn, stalked outside a foe on the backstretch and second turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged that rival for second. FORTY SUERTUDO (ARG) went three deep between foes on the first turn to vie for command, stalked a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn, split rivals in deep stretch and was edged for the place. MUD SHARK off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and found his best stride late. AMERICAN LIBERTY went up inside on the first turn, dueled along the rail, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. TOP HIT angled in and saved ground off the pace and did not rally. IBERO GRACE (ARG) allowed to settle outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. INTUIT came off the inside in the run to the first turn, chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened.
