FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$200 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$2,000 additional to start, with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which \$120,000 to first, \$40,000 to second, \$24,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$4,000 to fifth. The Rancho Bernardo Handicap has been selected as one of the Breeders' Cup "Win and You're In" Challenge Races. The winner of the Rancho Bernardo Handicap will be entitled to automatic entry into the 2009 running of the Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Sprint, subject to the payment of all pre-entry, entry and supplementary (if applicable) fees. To be eligible for the 2009 Breeders' Cup Championships to be held during the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita on November 6-7, 2009, all horses must be pre-entered by noon (local time at the designated pre-entry locations) by October 26, 2009. All applicable fees shall accompany the pre-entry. Weights Saturday, August 29. High weights preferred. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations Closed Thursday, August 27, 2009 with 15.

CARLSBAD had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away leaving the turn and drew off in the stretch under some urging and good handling. LADY LUMBERJACK stalked the pace inside, split rivals leaving the turn, was between foes into the stretch, came out some and was second best. GOLDEN DOC A broke inward and a bit slowly, settled inside, moved up along the rail on the turn, came out some into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and picked up the show. ASHLEY'S KITTY stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SHE'S CHEEKY was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. EVITA ARGENTINA was a bit slow into stride and bobbed slightly in the opening strides, settled outside a rival then off the rail, continued outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, angled out in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary late rally. SO LONG SONOMA chased off the rail, angled in some on the turn, was between horses into the stretch and did not rally. MOON DE FRENCH had good speed and dueled inside the winner, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. STOLEN HEART a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn and was not a threat.
