Footnotes

NORM'S PASSION sped to the early lead and angled in, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, drew off under left handed urging in the stretch and proved best under steady handling late. MIDNIGHT TRANSFER broke a bit slowly, went up inside then came off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and edged rivals for the place. CLEARLY A COWBOY stalked inside, split horses into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and was edged for second toward the inside. SKY KINGDOM stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and lost third. CASTAWAY chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. MR. NEWTON stalked a bit off the rail then inside, took an awkward step in midstretch and weakened. SIR ALLISON chased outside then three deep, came out five wide into the stretch, drifted in and lacked a further response. TRUCIAL STATE broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out in the stretch and failed to menace.
