GLOBAL sent inside to stalk the pace, moved up into the stretch, bid along the rail, took a short lead in midstretch and proved best under urging. HIGH MARGIN stalked the pace outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place late. FORWARD FILLY (SAF) chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival leaving the turn to loom a threat in the stretch, then split rivals late for third. SALTY HELEN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back outside the winner in the stretch, then could not match that one and lost a minor award late. FILIGREE chased off the rail then between horses early on the turn, was between foes again in upper stretch, came out in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. VENUSBERG (ARG) saved ground throughout to no avail. CHICHIM settled outside a rival, came out into the stretch and failed to menace.
