Footnotes

HIGH SILVER broke inward, sped to the early lead between horses, set the pace off the rail then dueled outside a rival on the turn and until midstretch and pulled clear under some urging and steady handling late. DEE DEE'S CAT sent between foes early, stalked inside, bid inside the winner and dueled on the turn and to midstretch, then could not match strides while clearly second best. LOVETRIP a bit slow into stride, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came a bit off the rail in midstretch and edged a rival for third. CIMARRON HILLS chased outside on the backstretch and three deep on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. BEACONTREE broke through the gate before the start, stalked between horses on the backstretch, steadied briefly in a bit tight early on the turn, continued between foes on the bend and lacked a response in the stretch. TON A RUN close up stalking the pace four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn weakened in the drive. TAKE A LONG LOOK squeezed at the start, settled off the rail, angled in off heels past the half mile pole, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MAGIC VICTORY broke slowly and steadied, angled in and saved ground to no avail. MAMMY lugged out early, angled back in on the backstretch, lugged out again into the turn and was not a factor. WINTER GOLD had good early speed and stalked between horses on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened.
