**Footnotes**

BOB AND JOHN stalked three deep, bid outside rivals on the backstretch and second turn to gain command, kicked clear and drew off in the stretch under a brisk hand ride. KISSIN KNIGHT chased off the rail, angled in and moved up leaving the second turn, came out in upper stretch and gained the place. TRANSDUCTION GOLD unhurried inside early, moved up along the rail into the stretch, came out past midstretch and picked up the show. CRAFTY ANG lugged out and steadied off heels into the first turn, stalked off the rail then between horses, went three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SARTORIAL in a bit tight into the first turn and forced out some, angled in and stalked inside, bid along the rail on the backstretch and second turn and weakened in the final furlong. REMEMBER ME also in a bit tight into the first turn, chased off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. SOLDIER BOB four wide into the first turn, chased outside or off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. BULLET TRAIN sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled briefly between horses on the second turn, dropped back nearing the quarter pole and gave way. HAVE YOUR CAKE off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground, moved up inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch, was pulled up passing the eighth pole and vanned off.
