WESTERLY MAGIC chased inside, went up along the rail to gain the lead leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. GALLARDO chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, advanced along the rail into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and went willingly to the wire. SMOOCHER angled in and settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the show. SWITZERLAND five wide into the first turn, stalked outside then alongside a rival, lacked room behind foes into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. CITY STORMER settled off the pace outside then off the rail, came six wide into the stretch and was not a threat.

GHOST ACTOR chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BELTLINE JACK prompted the pace between horses, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. YES HE'S A PISTOL dueled inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses nearing the quarter pole and also weakened. ONE ON THE HOUSE prompted the pace three deep, was four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and had little left. DENIED chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
