STAKES Del Mar Futurity Grade 1 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS (FOALS OF 2005). By subscription of \$250 each if made on or before June 1, 2007, the fee to accompany the nomination. All horses shall pay \$500 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weights: colts and geldings, 123 lbs.; fillies, 120 lbs. Non-winners of \$50,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race, 4 lbs. of \$25,000 other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Friday, June 1, 2007 with 219.

Footnotes

GEORGIE BOY wide between foes early, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses under urging in deep stretch to get up. SALUTE THE SARGE chased between horses and was in a bit tight on the turn, steadied off heels and came out into the stretch, split rivals twice in the stretch and finished gamely. DRILL DOWN stalked the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, bid along the rail in the stretch and held third. LEONIDES pulled his way between horses to chase the pace, bid three deep into and on the turn, was between rivals again into the stretch and in the drive and was outfinished. DIXIE CHATTER stalked the pace outside, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch to gain the lead, fought back outside until past midstretch and continued willingly but also was outfinished. KANAN DUME pulled his way along inside then between horses to stalk the pace, was in a bit tight on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary late response. E Z'S GENTLEMAN settled off the rail, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DREWTHEGENTLEMAN chased outside, went five wide on the turn and into the stretch and could

not summon the necessary response. OVEREXTENDED broke slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SKY CAPE chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. FORD ISLAND chased off the rail, steadied in tight between foes nearing the turn, angled in and lacked a further response. GOOD MAN DAN had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and weakened in the stretch. WHATEVER WHENEVER dueled outside a rival then between foes into and on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
