Footnotes

SOUPLY chased a bit off the rail then inside, awaited room into the stretch, continued inside in midstretch, came out and rallied under urging and strong handling between foes in deep stretch, gained the lead nearing the wire and prevailed. YES IT'S A CAT chased inside then a bit off the rail, went between

foes leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied between horses five wide on the line. CATASTIRE three deep early, angled in and settled inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied six wide on the wire. TRICKY CAUSEWAY sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail or inside, inched away again on the second turn, battled outside a rival in midstretch and between horses in deep stretch and went willingly to the wire. SMOOTH AND SAVVY pulled a bit early, stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid between foes past midstretch and was outfinished. TENT (IRE) pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, fought back past midstretch and also was outfinished. SOUVENIR SLEW settled as bit off the rail then outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and gained ground but could not offer the necessary late response. LANG FIELD squeezed a bit at the start, drifted out into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch, was in a bit close off heels in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. EPIC POWER pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside a rival, bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch, stalked again between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. ROBSCARVIC (IRE) three deep leaving the chute, angled in outside a rival then inside on the backstretch and second turn, swung out into the stretch and did not rally.
