Footnotes

SHRUG dueled between horses then outside the runner-up on the turn and through a long drive and gamely prevailed late under urging. CODE BUSTER had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, fought back through a stiff drive and continued gamely but lost the bob on the line. WAR PILOT close up stalking the pace inside, came out a bit in the stretch and bested the others. CHANNEL SURF came in early, prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail or outside a rival to the stretch and weakened some. TWICE THE APPEAL in a bit tight early, chased just off the rail or between foes to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PRAYER FOR RELIEF also in a bit tight early, chased outside or alongside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the turn and could not offer the necessary response. ALERT ROCKET settled outside chasing the pace, angled to the inside entering the stretch and weakened.
