MOON DE FRENCH sped to the early lead outside foes, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. DANCE TO MY TUNE tugged her way along to stalk the pace inside, came out a bit in midstretch, then drifted in and was second best. SILVER SWALLOW between horses early, chased just off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch and gained the show late. BURG BERG close up stalking the winner outside a rival to the stretch, was edged late for third. VALUE STREAM settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRIECAT pulled hard under a hold and came a bit off the rail on the first turn, angled back in and stalked the pace inside to the stretch and did not rally. MISS PLEASANT three deep early, stalked outside a rival to the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened.
