Footnotes

SUPREME SUMMIT angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, rallied to the front three wide in deep stretch and proved best under good handling. A LIL DUMAANI had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner but edged his pace rival for second. CLASSICAL SLEW dueled outside then alongside the runner-up, fought back in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and bested the rest. MOBILIZED chased outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. POSITION A settled outside chasing the pace, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRADY BLUE EYES chased a bit off the rail, split horses leaving the turn, continued alongside a rival into the stretch, found the inside in the drive and did not rally. GUNS ON THE TABLE stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and into the turn, continued three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened, was being eased up at the wire, was unsaddled into the clubhouse turn while bleeding from the nostrils, walked off the course then was vanned to the barn. WAR NATIVE (IRE) broke in and slowly, pulled his way up inside and steadied into the turn, continued along the rail, was in a bit tight in upper stretch and lacked a further response.
