CITY TO CITY angled in and stalked the pace inside, came out some in midstretch and rallied under urging to get by the runner-up in late stretch. MEDAGLIA D'AMOUR broke through the gate before the start, sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, inched away again on the second turn and held on gamely but was worn down late. GO FORTH NORTH settled off the pace inside then just out from the rail, swung five wide into the stretch and just got the show. ALL STAR HEART four wide early, angled in and chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, was between foes through the final furlong and was edged for third. TURNING TOP (IRE) saved ground chasing the pace, waited momentarily in midstretch then got through inside and was outfinished but shared fifth. ANDINA (IRE) stalked between horses, fell back some leaving the second turn, continued between rivals through the final furlong and was outfinished for a minor award. WELL MONIED broke a bit slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, angled out again nearing midstretch and found her best stride late. NINTH INFANTRY close up stalking the pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside the leader on the backstretch, tracked that one again on the second turn, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. IT TIZ well placed stalking the pace three deep to the stretch, steadied in a bit tight between foes nearing midstretch and also weakened.
