RENEESGOTZIP sped to the early lead, set all the pace along the inside and won clear under some urging and good handling. BYRAMA (GB) saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside leaving the turn and into the stretch and was second best. JET BLUE GIRL bobbled a bit at the start, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and picked up the show. PINK LOLLIPOPS stalked outside a rival, continued three wide leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened. CANDREA dropped back off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GIVINE (FR) broke outward and a bit awkwardly, chased outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and could not offer the necessary response in the stretch. SIZZLING GOLD bobbled a bit at the start, stalked just off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. ELVIES LANE broke a bit slowly, chased inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and did not rally.
