DRY SUMMER stalked three deep then outside a rival, went three wide leaving the backstretch and into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. POWER BROKER bumped at the start, had speed between foes and angled in, dueled inside, fought back to a short advantage in deep stretch but could not hold off the winner. CAUGHT NAPPING (GB) pulled his way along inside then saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and finished well. BUCKLEBERRY GREY dueled outside a rival, put a head back in front in the stretch, battled between foes in deep stretch and was edged for the show. SHINING COPPER chased outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and went on willingly between foes late. HE'S HAD ENOUGH angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. RESISTANT bumped at the start, pulled early, stalked between horses or outside a rival to the stretch and weakened. PARISIAN PRINCE (IRE) hesitated to be away slowly, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn and did not rally. FOREST BOY broke out and bumped a rival, had speed inside and saved ground stalking the pace but weakened in the stretch.
