FLOATING FEATHER had speed three deep then stalked outside a rival, continued between foes leaving the turn, bid between rivals in the stretch, gained a slim lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. HALF DOME DUDE chased outside or off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and closed willingly. BET ON VICTOR chased between horses then outside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch, gained a short lead four wide in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and was outfinished. MAGIC BEAM bumped at the start, moved up inside to stalk the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch and could quite not offer the needed late kick. SOUTHERN STYLE chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. ROYAL F J wide early, angled in and chased a bit off the rail, found the inside on the turn, was blocked and steadied off heels past the eighth pole, came out and was outfinished. DEADLY CATCH chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out in the stretch, bid between foes

in midstretch and weakened some late. ROYAL PRODUCTION sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back in the stretch and weakened late. PALIO PRINCE bobbled sharply at the start, settled off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SHEDIAK (FR) chased off the rail then outside a rival, steadied in tight off heels into the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EL VINO settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out some in the stretch, angled out off heels in midstretch and did not rally.
