Footnotes

FAIRLY RANSOM pulled his way along and angled in early to stalk the pace, came out into the stretch, gained a short advantage between horses past midstretch and gamely prevailed under some urging. DEVIOUS BOY (GB) prompted the early pace three deep then stalked outside a rival, bid three wide into the stretch, could not match the winner late but held second. SWEET RETURN (GB) angled in outside a rival then found the rail on the first turn, chased inside, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and finished with interest. SENOR SWINGER came off the inside into the first turn, chased between horses, moved up some outside leaving the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. SINGLETARY took the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, held on well until past midstretch and weakened late. MIDDLEWEIGHT between horses early, prompted the pace outside SINGLETARY, stalked outside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BIS REPETITAS saved ground off the pace, bid inside in the stretch but could not summon the needed late kick. OUTTA HERE a bit wide into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. PUMA (IRE) off a bit slowly and slightly crowded at the start, settled three deep then outside a foe on the second turn and did not rally.
