OUR NEW RECRUIT dueled three deep then four wide midway on the turn, continued three wide leaving the bend, gained the lead in upper stretch and won clear under a crack of the whip and good handling. BLUESTHESTANDARD stalked the pace a bit off the rail then outside a rival into the turn, split horses with a bid on the turn to put a head in front, could not match the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. NEWARK stalked inside, was in a bit tight nearing midway on the turn, came out in upper stretch and bested the others. KAMSACK chased off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ONEBADSHARK allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some leaving the backstretch, came outside a rival into the stretch and also could not offer the necessary response. MARINO MARINI had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch, then was unsaddled a pole from the wire but walked off. ROY JONES settled inside off the pace, remained along the rail and failed to menace. TOUGH GAME had good early speed off the rail then dueled between foes, dropped back leaving the turn and weakened.
