Footnotes

BLACKDOUN (FR) unhurried and angled in early, settled a bit off the rail, was in a bit tight off heels on the second turn, rallied between horses in the stretch, gained a short lead under left handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely. TOASTED saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, also rallied between foes in the drive and continued willingly between horses late. LAURA'S LUCKY BOY stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, inched clear, then fought back inside the top pair to the wire. TERROPLANE (FR) pulled between horses then chased a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. FAST AND FURIOUS (FR) angled in and settled just off the inside, steadied off heels midway on the second turn, came out in midstretch and also put in a late bid outside. SEMI LOST stalked outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, steadied late when the top pair went past and was outfinished. PLACE COWBOY (IRE) saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BEDMAR (GB) pulled between foes and steadied in tight leaving the chute, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LUCKY PULPIT pulled his way to the early lead, drifted out a bit leaving the chute then angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SUJIMOTO pulled a bit early, stalked outside then three deep into the second turn, dropped back on that turn and gave way. A claim of foul by the rider of SEMI LOST against the winner was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the latter was not the cause of that one's trouble.
