**Footnotes**

PRIVILAGED dueled between horses then inside on the turn, inched clear in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging and strong handling. BRADY BLUE EYES forced in and bumped at the start, chased between foes then a bit off the rail, went around a rival leaving the turn, found the inside into the stretch and got up for the place. MACIAS broke slowly, moved up inside, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and was edged late for second. SETSUKO settled off the rail, came out in the stretch and found his best stride late. LIGHTNIN' UP came in onto foes at the start, stalked off the rail, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. DEPUTY MAX broke out and bumped a rival, chased outside a foe, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and did not rally. ICEY TEMPER angled in and dueled three deep then outside the winner on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FAMILIAR SHINE allowed to settle outside then off the rail, angled in some for the turn and did not rally. DAVE'S RULER off a bit slowly, pulled early, settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. CIMARRON STAR had good early speed and dueled inside, dropped back on the turn and had little left for the stretch. RETAINER bumped hard between foes at the start, dropped back off the rail, was pulled up on the backstretch and vanned off.
