CONNAGHER settled off the pace inside, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and rallied under urging with a late surge to get up on the wire. SQUARE DEAL prompted the pace three deep, took a short lead into the stretch, inched away under urging, kicked clear but was caught on the line. MENSA HEAT chased off the rail, came out into the stretch, rallied between horses in deep stretch and was in a bit tight on the wire. SASSOU had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened some in the final furlong. GET FUNKY allowed to settle off the rail then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MOONLARK dueled between horses, angled to the inside into the stretch and weakened. INDIAN ASHTON unhurried off the inside on the backstretch, continued alongside a rival on the turn and did not rally. GALLETA MONSTRUO broke in the air and slowly, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
