Footnotes

JOE CARL unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn, came five wide into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. SKELLYTOWN stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, took the lead nearing midstretch, fought back off the rail through the final furlong and continued willingly. STREETS OF HEAVEN stalked the pace inside, came out for room and clipped heels but quickly recovered nearing midstretch, went around rivals in deep stretch and picked up the show. SHEEKEY (IRE) chased outside a rival, steadied off heels nearing midstretch, split foes and lacked the needed rally. SEVEN POINT ONE sent to the early lead outside, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. LUCIUS ANTONIUS stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the second turn and into the stretch, had his heels clipped in midstretch and also weakened. SMOOTH AND SAVVY saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and into the stretch and did not rally. BONJOUR (NZ) stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied while dropping back between horses nearing midstretch and had little left in the final furlong.
