LOOKN EAST took the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail while trying to get out, inched away again on the second turn and cleared in the final furlong under urging. BRING HOME THEGOLD pulled his way along stalking the early pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, split rivals in deep stretch and gained the place. WAINGARTH pulled outside a rival then between horses, tugged his way alongside the winner on the backstretch, stalked that one a bit off the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, could not match that one in the drive and lost second late. MOTTO angled in three deep into the first turn then chased outside a rival, continued between horses on the backstretch, found the rail for the second turn, continued inside and was edged for a minor award. SIR ALFRED angled in and settled toward the inside, came out and moved up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch but could not sustain the bid in the drive. GALLANT (GB) off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally. GREEN JARO (FR) pulled his way up four wide into and on the first turn, chased outside on the backstretch, dropped back three deep on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. GOLDEN GENERAL pulled between horses stalking the early pace, went four wide on the backstretch, angled in some for the second turn and weakened. NICK (CHI) threw his head at the start, saved ground chasing the pace and had little left in the stretch.
