SHEZASUMMERBREEZE prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch, stalked outside on the turn, re-bid in the lane, collared the leader in deep stretch, inched away and held under urging. RESPECTFUL stalked along the inside on the backstretch and turn, came out into the stretch and finished well. CHASTITY BELLE settled off the rail on the backstretch, went outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch, angled in past midstretch and gained the show late. CINNFUL BRIDE bumped just after the start, went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, could not match the winner late and was edged for a minor award. CHAPEAU bumped at the start, chased outside a rival then between horses leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and weakened. SUGAR FREE broke in and bumped a rival, settled outside then three deep leaving the backstretch, went four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SUMMERWOOD had speed off the rail then dueled between horses, stalked and angled in on the turn and weakened. SILVER MAGIC squeezed at the start, angled in and saved ground to no avail.
