Footnotes

JOHN SCOTT a bit slow into stride, came off the rail early, moved up three deep on the turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging while drifting in and was along in time. DAYLIGHT STORM had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, fought back when headed in the stretch to regain the advantage a sixteenth out and continued willingly but was caught late. TRIBAL FACE stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, took a short lead outside the runner-up in midstretch and bested the others. KILLER BEAR chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and improved position. GRACE UPON GRACE prompted the pace between horses then stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. WOLF TAIL allowed to settle outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. BERTRAN HILL saved ground chasing the pace throughout and lacked a response in the stretch. SWEET TIGGER prompted the pace four wide then stalked outside, angled in alongside a rival leaving the turn, came out in the stretch and weakened. MINISTERFROMMIAMI unhurried and angled in outside a rival early, came out on the turn and was not a factor. YOGAROO dueled between horses then stalked between foes, came three deep into the stretch, dropped back between horses, was being pulled up in the final sixteenth and walked off.
