DRILL chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, inched forward inside leaving the backstretch, came out for room on the turn, angled out into the stretch, bid five wide under left handed urging past midstretch, had the rider lose the whip nearing the sixteenth marker, was bumped hard in the final strides but got up late. MAJESTIC CITY stalked a bit off the rail then between horses leaving the backstretch, continued just off the inside on the turn and into the stretch, bid between rivals past midstretch, drifted out under left handed urging to bump hard with CREATIVE CAUSE while putting a head in front nearing the wire and was edged late. CREATIVE CAUSE stalked outside then three deep leaving the backstretch and on the turn and into the stretch, bid four wide between foes past midstretch, was bumped hard between horses and steadied nearing the wire. GUN BOAT had good early speed and set a pressured pace inside, fought back through the stretch and was outfinished. BASMATI pulled his way along to duel outside a rival, fought back in midstretch, was between foes past midstretch and weakened some late. SHEER TALENT chased inside, came off the rail on the turn, swung out into the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. CORSA DI CAVALLI broke slowly, settled then came off the rail on the backstretch, angled back in, saved ground on the turn and did not rally. MIGHTY MONSOON also a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail or outside a rival, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. Following a stewards' inquiry, MAJESTIC CITY was disqualified and placed third for interference nearing the wire.
