FOR TWO-YEAR-OLDS (Foals of 1997). By subscription of \$250 each if made on or before June 4, 1999, the fee to accompany the nomination. For horses not nominated, supplementary nominations of \$10,000 each will close at the time of entry, Sunday, September 5. All horses shall pay \$500 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weights: colts and geldings, 121 lbs.; fillies, 118 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race, 4 lbs.; of \$15,000 other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 8 lbs.

FOREST CAMP pulled his way along under a hard hold three deep on the backstretch and had the saddle slip a bit forward, took command four wide into the turn, angled in on a clear advantage leaving the bend and into the stretch, was pushed along a bit to open up and won under a very mild hand ride. DIXIE UNION, broke inward, dueled outside CAMERON PASS, was three deep into and on the turn, was no match for the winner but clearly second best. CAPTAIN STEVE, climbing early, angled in and bid inside into the turn, continued just off the rail and held third. COMMENDABLE, close up between rivals early, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed response. CAMERON PASS, a bit crowded at the start, dueled inside DIXIE UNION but a bit off the rail, was between rivals into and on the turn, then drifted out and weakened.
