QUOTED stalked between horses, found the inside in upper stretch, came out in midstretch, bid between rivals a sixteenth out, gained the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under a left handed tap of the whip and good handling. PRIDE OF WILSHIRE five wide early, stalked four wide then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, bid three wide past midstretch and continued willingly outside the winner. MY MAN MARTY close up stalking the pace between horses, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and edged rivals for the show. GRAND TOPPER sped to the early lead and angled in, inched away leaving the backstretch, found the rail and met a bid on the turn, inched away again into the stretch, fought back in deep stretch and was edged late for third. LIME A NITE broke in a bit, went up inside to press then stalk the pace, continued along the rail on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. BOLD TYPE was in a good position stalking the pace between horses, bid between rivals then outside a foe on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
