All horses shall pay \$500 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$250,000 Guaranteed, of which \$150,000 to first, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$5,000 to fifth. Weights: colts and geldings, 121 lbs.; fillies, 118 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race, 4 lbs. of \$25,000 other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 8 lbs. ICECOLDBEERATREDS sped to the early lead and came off the rail, dueled inside TOTAL ADVANTAGE early then outside BULL MARKET, regained the advantage leaving the turn, inched clear and held gamely under some urging and strong handling while drifting in late. KAFWAIN between horses early, stalked a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, bid inside, came off the rail in deep stretch and was second best. CHIEF PLANNER chased a bit off the rail, also angled in on the turn, came out in upper stretch and edged a rival for third late. FRIENDLY MIKE stalked the dueling leaders a bit off the inside, swung out into the stretch and just lost the show. OUTTA HERE allowed to settle outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BULL MARKET off a bit slowly, steadied when squeezed in the opening strides, went up inside on the backstretch, dueled inside the winner but weakened in the stretch. TOTAL ADVANTAGE had speed outside to press the early pace, stalked approaching the turn, dropped back between horses on the bend and also weakened. GENTLEMEN'S CLUB was in a good stalking position outside on the backstretch, went three deep on the turn and had little left in the stretch.
