CURFEW TOWER set the pressured pace along the inside, opened clear midway through the turn, widened into the stretch and maintained a safe advantage. VENTURA BAR broke slow, rushed to contention between horses, was blocked and waited near the five-sixteenths pole, got through and finished well but was unable to reach the winner. WENDY AND HER CATS was close up three wide, drifted about entering the turn and tightened up VENTURA BAR and SHADOW SECRETARY, steadied off heels nearing the five-sixteenths pole, bore out leaving the turn, was straightened away and came again to earn the show. SHADOW SECRETARY settled saving ground, was caught in tight near the seven-sixteenths pole when VENTURA BAR was forced in, came again to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GOSPEL HOUR was allowed to settle, moved up four wide on the turn, was carried out further when WENDY AND HER CAT came out, and came up empty thereafter. LITTLE SADIE was unhurried into stride between horses, finished with a belated gain but failed to seriously threaten. SIR WILLIAM pressed the pace two wide, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. ZIP IT TO ME was through early. Following an objection the Stewards conducted an inquiry into the run through the turn, but made no change to the order of finish.
