### Footnotes

IMPLICATE pressed the pace three wide, forged command with a furlong to run and held stubbornly. NOT A LADY settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. LADY LANNIS set the pressured pace off of the inside, battled through a long drive but grudgingly gave in late. DAKOTA DIM broke slow, was unhurried into stride, split horses and improved position. MISS ELIZA was away a step slow, rushed to contention four wide, but flattened entering the stretch and faded. THERES ALWAYS HOPE broke in the air, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. HONEY C was through early. MISS DEWEESE INLET chased the pace four wide, but stopped before going a half.
