AMY'S BUDDHA set the pressured pace off of the inside, edged clear with a furlong to run, and was fully extended to just last. IRVING RULES stalked the pace four wide, moved into striking position through the turn, continued on fairly well but was unable to reach the winner. SPIKEY ITALIANO attended the pace along the inside, got through and was up in time to earn the show. WHY STILLY WHY was allowed to settle, circled five wide and loomed a danger with a furlong to run but lacked the needed late response. NIMO pressed the pace two wide, but weakened in the final furlong and faded. CASSOULET was allowed to settle, circled six wide but lacked the needed late response. WILDWOOD WINNER was unhurried into stride and was never a factor. CAUSE CAUSE CAUSE settled five wide and failed to respond. MOCC ME NOW showed little.
