HOMETOWN LEGEND behind the leaders in hand, angled out and moved to challenge three wide with three furlongs to go then drew off under steady urging. BAIL BONDSMAN vied for the lead inside, responded willingly when the winner ranged up on the outside, battled into the final furlong and held on for the place and was vanned off after pulling up. A J'S FORTUNE within striking distance three wide, moved near the rail approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. THEODORE'S CASH far back early inside, made a good run to the quarter mile marker but had no late bid. HE CAN HE WILL four wide early, alternated for the lead, moved in to the two path on the second turn and gave way in the drive. EL POO within striking distance four wide, faded. PARK AND FLY with the leaders between rivals, stopped.
