STAKES Ellis Park Turf S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. Free nomination, \$250 to pass the entry box and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at time of entry by payment of \$2,500 each (includes entry and starting fees).

With \$50,000 guaranteed. The Association's money to be divided: 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: Three-Year-Olds, 119 lbs. Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 twice at a mile or over on the turf in 2013 allowed 2 lbs., \$27,000 twice at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 4 lbs., This race will be limited to 12 starters. Should more than 12 entries pass the entry box, the starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Graded Stakes Winners then those horses having accumulated the highest earnings in 2012-2013. Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. The winning owner to receive a trophy. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One mile out of the chute.)

### Footnotes

MY PERFECT TEN settled in hand three wide, closed the gap through the second turn, tipped out five wide entering the stretch, struck the front a furlong out and kicked clear. RUN A RISK hopped at the start, settled saving ground, moved up along the inside on the second turn, shifted out off of the rail, split horses inside the furlong marker and was just up to earn the place. SOFT WHISPER was close up three wide, drew even near the three-eighths pole, but weakened during the drive and just failed to hold the place. HEAVENLY LANDING attended the pace four wide, moved up to join the vanguard midway through the second turn, but faltered between rivals in the final furlong and faded. BEIJOCA bobbled at the start, lagged well back, finished with a belated gain between horses but was never a factor. TIMEZONE showed little. NEW WAVE sped clear to set the pace, faltered after six furlongs and gave way readily once headed.
