### Footnotes

ALI OLAH gained a slight edge early while battling outside of HOURMISSREMY, shook her off, then was hard ridden in the drive to move clear. LA ESCONDIDA, well placed near the inside, angled out for the drive, had aim at the winner but wasn't good enough. LOGOLD broke in the air, bobbed when landing, was outrun to the lane and closed a late gap. MISS AMBER, up close inside early, eased out three or four wide on the turn and flattened out in the drive. IN CASE OF WIND had no rally. ASHLAR wasn't a factor. HOURMISSREMY contested the pace inside the winner for three furlongs and couldn't keep pace.
