Footnotes

KITTY'S TURN vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear in upper stretch and stayed clear under steady urging. FROGGYVILLE forwardly placed near the rail, lacked a late bid along the inside but was clearly second best. SURF CAST within striking distance three wide, lacked a late bid. LAOPE behind the leaders in the three path, tired in the drive. NOTORIETY outrun early, made a four wide run late on the turn but had nothing left in the stretch. ARRIVED HOME within striking distance four wide, moved out a bit late on the turn and could not threaten. GAMBLING DON outrun early, raced near the rail late on the turn and was no factor. RICHMOND alternated for the lead three wide and faded in the drive. EIGHT RIDERS was outrun while wide.
