MARCHING ORDERS settled off of the inside, advanced between horses, tipped out six wide entering the stretch, quickened once clear, reeled in the leaders and edged clear late. SEA SONG'S HAMMER tracked the pace three wide, forged command entering the stretch, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner late. BIMAH settled saving ground, waited in traffic entering the stretch, split horses and was along for the show. ELUSIVE VIDAR set the pressured pace between horses, weakened entering the stretch and gave way. VOUCHER pulled between horses, was bottled up and steadied on the turn, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. BOB'S GONE WILD was allowed to settle, finished with a mild rally between horses and failed to threaten. GRAND IDOL vied for the lead three wide to the stretch and gave way. TRUE PARADISE contended off of the inside but lacked a response when called upon. ELUSIVE MALE was close up four wide through the turn and tired. QUEEN'S ESCORT failed to respond. COURTROOM DRAMA wide trip and was never a factor. TIZ THE GENERAL trailed.
