**Footnotes**

THERES ALWAYS HOPE was away alertly and opened clear to set the pace, widened the advantage entering the stretch and scored as the rider pleased. INDIAN NATIVE was bumped at the start and slow into stride, advanced along the inside, steadied from tight quarters near the seven-sixteenths pole, came again and swung to the outside leaving the turn, continued on well but failed to menace the winner. PAIGE MARGE tracked the pace three wide, offered a mild bid leaving the turn, but drifted out through the drive and settled for the show. BURNINGRICH was unhurried into stride, made a late rally from between horses and improved position. REBAR settled in hand, tucked in to save ground, came four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. MY SWEET MATTY G was allowed to settle, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. SHUG was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and retreated. WAVE LAND ASHLEY was hustled along four wide for a contending position, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. TWISTER IN DIXIE hopped at the start to get away slowly, closed the gap between horses but was used up after a half and dropped out. PRINCESS GIOVANNI showed little. DOGWOODS JUMPER bumped at the start and trailed throughout.
