Footnotes

CABAZON tracked the pace along the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, split horses and was up in the final strides. NATIONAL DAY opened clear to set the pace, was collared after five furlongs, dug in gamely to meet the challenge, kept on well but was denied in the last jump. SLICK PARDONED ME attended the pace four wide, drew even leaving the second turn, continued on willingly but wasn't quite good enough. CORNWHISKEY was unhurried into stride, made a steady advance circling six wide but was left with too much to do. REVIVAL RIDGE contended between horses, came five wide but lacked the needed late response. IGOTITGOTITGOTIT settled saving ground, slipped through to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. SUDDENLY PERFECT made a middle move between horses to close the gap but weakened during the drive. MR. RANCHO VISTA chased the pace three wide, but faltered from between horses in the final furlong and faded. HOT SKY failed to respond. B L'S PAPA COO COO was forwardly placed three wide for a half and dropped out. B L'S TSUMANI was through early, eased to the wire but walked off.
