Footnotes

PROSPECTOR MATTIE broke a step slow, advanced into contention four wide, drew even with a furlong to run and wore down MONKEY DUST in the final strides. MONKEY DUST tracked the pace three deep, forged a slim edge entering the stretch, battled gamely but wasn't quite good enough. SEDUCING MR. G angled in to set the pressured pace, disputed the issue to the stretch, was unable to match strides with the top two but kept on fairly well to hold the show. BARBATINA was allowed to settle, made a late rally circling five wide and improved her position. UNDER SAIL attended the pace along the inside, shifted out and bid between horses nearing the quarter pole, drifted out further in the drive and failed to sustain the bid. APPLE PANDOWDY prompted the pace between horses for six furlongs and faded. SLEW CITY ROUGE was through early.
