Footnotes

SUN AT MIDSUMMER gained the lead early, moved inside, went along under careful handling, was engaged on the second turn from the outside by ROANOKE LADY, then held sway under strong handling. BETTY'S TIME BOMB, never far back, made a run four or five wide into the upper stretch, loomed boldly but wasn't good enough. ROANOKE LADY, well placed three or four wide, challenged the winner on the second turn and into the stretch, loomed menacingly but wasn't good enough. MRS. GUILTY, outrun to the far turn, made a run five wide into the stretch but failed to sustain the needed momentum. PLEASANT PURSUIT, outrun until the stretch, offered a mild gain. IWANA failed to rally in an even effort. BEVIE'S PARTY went up early to press the winner from the outside, held on well until midway of the second turn and weakened. TENDER MEMORY raced in contention for six furlongs and weakened. CHEROKEE RAIN was finished after a half. SING OUT BABY was outrun.
