LEAD STORY, reserved soon after the start three wide, eased out between foes five wide approaching the final quarter, caught front-running CLEAR DESTINY a furlong out, then drove clear under brisk left-handed urging. CLEAR DESTINY, never far back, moved steadily four or five wide to reach the front at the five-sixteenths pole, was headed by the winner a furlong out and continued willingly as second best. BORN TO DANCE, close up inside from the start, fell back a bit, moved four or five wide on the far turn, loomed prominently into the final furlong but failed to respond. RAVISH ME gained a slim lead early, lost the edge on the far turn to CLEAR DESTINY, continued forwardly to the stretch and gradually weakened. SEVEN FOUR SEVEN bumped the side of the gate at the break, was outrun to the stretch, then not a threat while improving position. REASON TO TALK, close up between rivals early, was checked in tight at the three-quarter pole, recovered, continued within easy striking distance five wide to the stretch but flattened out when straightened for the drive. FLY BORBOLETA raced four or five wide most of the way and never menaced. BEAT YOUR FEET tracked the pace to the far turn while four or five wide and tired. RED N'GOLD forced the pace early while four or five wide and faded on the far turn.
