KID RIGO set the pace inside, repulsed a bid by AWKWARD MOMENT on the second turn and drew off under steady urging. ILLINI MO close up along the inside, lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. NAFASS forwardly placed off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive but lacked a late bid. AWKWARD MOMENT close up three wide, challenged the winner on the second turn but tired in the drive. WILD U R outrun to the stretch, lodged a mild late bid off the inside. PERFECT SAND far back to the stretch, found his best stride too late. DAPPLED could not menace. BULBRUSH stumbled at the start, was reserved in the three path and could not menace. FORMAL ETIQUETTE within striking distance, raced in the three path on the second turn and faded. PA KETTLE four wide early, gained good position but gave way in the final quarter.
