CRAWLEYVILLE moved inside to contest the pace early, took over approaching the stretch, edged clear, then was kept to her task to hold PREMIER PEAK safe. The latter, never far back, rallied six wide into the stretch and finished well. BARE LEGS saved ground from early on while stalking the leaders, angled out for the drive but lacked a serious response. BURRITO saved ground in a striking position into the stretch and weakened. SILK SAILS, outrun until the stretch, offered a mild gain while unable to menace. CORONA HILLS wasn't a factor. GOOSEY GANDER was finished after three-eighths. WILDWOOD PENNY gained a narrow lead early, showed the way until approaching the stretch and tired.
