Footnotes

AFTERNOON SLEW bobbed lightly at the start and was bumped soon after by ROYAL MINT, moved up inside to contest the pace, was checked lightly at the half-mile ground, took over midway of the turn, edged clear, then was under mild urging to hold CAMETOPLAY safe. The latter moved up quickly from the outside to force the pace, put a head in front briefly beginning the turn between calls, fell back slightly, then held on stubbornly the remainder as second best. MALENA, never far back, loomed menacingly five or six wide for the last eighth but couldn't muster the needed response. ROYAL MINT bobbed at the start and leaned in bumping the winner, was bumped soon after from the outside by LIVELY STORM, was outrun until the stretch and offered a mild gain. SARAH'S VICTRESS broke in front to gain a slight lead, lost it early on the turn and weakened gradually. TIME FOR RUBY failed to rally in an even effort. LADY WOODWIN, outrun for a half, improved position eight wide while not a threat. PRINCESS IVORINA was done early. RADIOACTIVE GAL gave way early. RUPERT'S APPROVAL was outrun, as was LIVELY STORM after the latter leaned in at the start bumping ROYAL MINT. APRIL FU gave way early and distanced when not persevered with.
