Footnotes

LITTLERIVERQUEEN ducked in at the start bumping GRANDPA'S GRAY, settled in hand near the inside, eased out six wide on the second turn to advance, continued in that manner into the stretch and edged clear late under steady encouragement. RODES HEARTNUT, squeezed back at the start, eased to the inside, saved ground in hand, rallied from the rail and finished with good energy. DELAMERE moved up early to press front-running VILLAGE GREEN from between horses, gained a slim advantage on the second turn, then weakened late. JOVE'S AUBEE, always well placed while between foes three or four wide, continued prominently into the last eighth but was empty. GRANDPA'S GRAY, bumped at the start, forced the pace four wide into the final furlong, was on about even terms for the lead and flattened out. SAN DARE, within striking distance while following the leaders four or five wide, flattened out in the final furlong. VILLAGE GREEN drifted in at the start on RODES HEARTNUT, moved to the fore soon after while working her way inward, showed the way for five furlongs and weakened. MILAN'S MELODY saved ground but failed to menace. MARK IT drifted out at the start bumping RODES HEARTNUT and was finished upon going a half. DUPLICATE DEPOSIT never was close.
