### Footnotes

SO ENTICING, well placed near the inside early, eased out three wide for the drive, gained a clear advantage in the upper stretch and continued under strong handling. GOLDEN RACHAEL, settled in behind foes three wide early, angled out entering the upper stretch, loomed prominently for the last eighth but wasn't good enough. THUNDER SANDS, always well placed while between foes, lacked a closing account. AZURE, outrun until the stretch, rallied between horses five wide and offered a mild gain. LADY CHELSEA, within striking distance four or five wide to the stretch, was empty the last eighth. EARLY AND BRIGHT gained a clear advantage early, raced off the inside, drifted out six or seven wide into the upper stretch and faded. GLITTER MUSIC, well placed between rivals three or four wide to the stretch, tired in the drive.
